INTRODUCTION

The 1 Day Emergency First Aid at Work Course (EFAW) is the qualification required if a person wishes, with approval from their employer, to act as a First Aider in the workplace environment. This 1 Day course is suitable for areas of employment considered to be "LOW RISK" i.e. offices, shops, libraries etc

This qualification is approved by the Health & Safety Executive (HSE) under the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.

The qualification can only be offered by approved HSE training organisations. The approval number can be requested from training organisations by potential customers to validate their approval rating.

The 1 Day (EFAW) course normally runs over 1 full day of 6hrs duration. However the course is flexible and can be run over any time duration to suit an employer's specific requirements e.g. related to shift patterns etc.

Two aspects of flexibility need to be taken into consideration:

- 1. Once the course starts, irrespective of the format the course must be completed within a maximum period of 3 weeks.
- 2. The smallest taught part of the course cannot be less than 2hrs duration.

There is no practical assessment at the end of this course, assessment is via the course instructor using a continuous assessment startegy throughout the course duration.

P.F.E. deliver this course throughout the U.K. The course can be run on an employer's own site were suitable training facilities exist.

THE SYLLABUS

The Course syllabus is laid down in the Approved Code of Practice of the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.

The syllabus, currently must be taught within the remit of the ACOP, although this may change in the future.

P.F.E. provide an Emergency First Aid at Work Handbook for each candidate attending this course. The Handbook covers the following aspects of the HSE syllabus:

- 1. Introduction to First Aid at Work & Role of the First Aider
- 2. The importance of basic hygiene in first aid procedures
- 3. Assessing the situation in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency
- 4. Administer first aid to an unconscious casualty / epilepsy
- 5. Administer CPR Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation
- 6. Administer first aid to a wounded or bleeding / shock casualty
- 7. Administer first aid to a casualty who is choking
- 8. Provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries.

Assessment is by continuous assessment on the course, there are no end of course examinations to perform.

Please note that the HSE expect you to attend a 3hr basic skills update course each year during the lifetime of your 3 year certificate. For information on the Basic Skills Update Course - click on the relevant tab on our main page under "COURSE INFORMATION".
